Israeli communiques reported two air strikes against Arab guerilla bases on Mount Hermon. The Israelis said the raids were in retaliation for Arab guerilla attacks on Israeli border settlements. A Lebanese spokesman at the United Nations said the Israeli force included "two companies (of troops), armored forces and planes." Guerillas at Odds In accepting the U.S.-initiated cease-fire Aug. 7, Israel reserved the right to strike back at guerillas operating from neighboring Arab territory. The Palestinian guerillas rejected the 90-day cease-fire and vowed to sabotage any

Fighting in Jordan V Meanwhile, from Amman, Jordan, The Associated Press reported renewed fighting last night between the Jordanian army and Palestinian guerillas, a few hours after both sides announced they had agreed to disengage from their current confrontation. Also the Associated Press said Libya announced yesterday that it would suspend its financial aid to Jordan because of the continuing guerilla clashes. Libya had been committed to give Jordan an annual subsidy of \$28.8 million.

...Missile Buildup Reported Behind Egypt's Truce Zone New York (UPI) Secret U.S. reconnaissance pictures show that the Russians and Egyptians have taken advantage of the Middle East cease-fire to provide Egypt with the most massive anti-aircraft system ever created. Time magazine reported yesterday. It said although the United States conceded last week that the Egyptians had violated the cease-fire by bringing more missiles into the 32-mile-wide standstill zone, it did not disclose these Soviet surface-to-air missiles (SAM) constitute "only the first line" of defense. ...Before the anti war group re ached the F. C. Fitting farm about 6 last night, they conducted a military "incident" in Stockton, N. J., across the Delaware River from Center Bridge, Pa. A young man imitating a Viet Cong was prodded with rifles as he walked with the group. There was a small turnout of residents of the two bridge-connected towns to witness the marchers. Most of the 81 marchers were white men, with a few black men and several women. Most of them were in their twenties, many wearing army combat fatigues and army boots. Several wore red arm bands, which a marcher said, indicated they were actually wounded in combat. After crossing the bridge, the marchers had a prearranged meeting in Center Bridge on a grassy traffic island with members of a group called Making A Nation (MAN). The Rev. James Bevel, executive of MAN, an aide to the late Dr. Martin Luther King, said, "The U. S. and its leaders have lost direction and are headed for the destruction of the human race.
